1	What is a bird?
Ans.	An animal covered in feathers, with a pair of wings, and beak is called a bird.
2.	What do you mean by flight feathers?
	Long and sturdy feathers found in wings and tails to help in flying are called flight feathers.
3.	What do you mean by down feathers?
Ans.	Down feathers are small and fluffy. They keep the bird's body warm in cold weather.
4	What do you mean by body feathers?
Ans.	The feathers that cover and give shape to the body of the bird are called body feathers.

Ans.	A bird uses its beak to eat and it also protects a bird from enemies.
